Commonly, these defendants have special issues due to the diminishment of driving skills caused by the natural aging process. In addition, as a person ages the influence of prescription and non-prescription drugs, including over-the-counter medications, often impacts their ability to drive safely. This webcast looks at current national statistics on the older driver, discusses common causes of impairment in this population, and offers some workable sentencing options, including knowing when to restrict or remove a driver's license.
